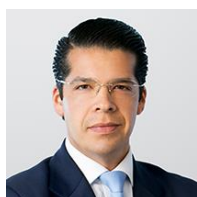

Our group takes an interdisciplinary approach to the following matters:

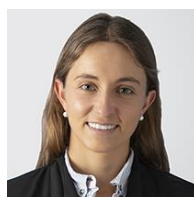
