PLAINTIFFS/JUDGMENT CREDITORS' <u>UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION</u> <u>OF TIME TO REPLY TO BANK OF AMERICA'S ANSWER</u>

Plaintiffs/Judgment Creditors Roman Leonov, Steven Hansen, and Jonathan Zarley ("Judgment Creditors"), by and through undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 6(b)(1)(A) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, hereby file their *Unopposed* Motion for Extension of Time to reply to Bank of America, N.A.'s "Answer of Garnishee and Demand to Plaintiff for Payment of Attorney's Fees" [ECF No. 257]. Judgment Creditors request an additional fourteen (14) days to file their reply, whereby Judgment Creditors would have until June 11, 2024. In support of this Motion, Judgment Creditors state:

1. On March 8, 2024, the Court entered a Final Default Judgment in favor of Judgment Creditors and against Defendant/Judgment Debtor ShopoStar, LLC ("ShopoStar") totaling \$1,116,000.00. See ECF No. 253.

- 2. On April 23, 2024, Judgment Creditors filed a Motion for Writ of Garnishment, requesting that the Clerk of Court issue a Writ of Garnishment directed to Bank of America, N.A. ("Garnishee"). *See* ECF No. 254. The Clerk of Court issued the Writ of Garnishment the following day [ECF No. 255, the "Writ"], and on April 30, 2024, Judgment Creditors served the Writ and its corresponding motion on Shopostar [ECF No. 256].
- 3. On May 8, 2024, Garnishee filed its answer to the Writ, stating that "Garnishee was not indebted to Defendant(s), Shopostar, LLC." ECF No. 257 ¶ 1 (the "Answer"). Pursuant to prior correspondence with Garnishee, Judgment Creditors believe this was an error and have communicated with Garnishee's counsel regarding same. Garnishee's counsel has confirmed that Garnishee is in fact indebted to Shopostar and plans to file an amended answer, but it requires additional time to complete a search of its records and file its amended answer.
- 4. Judgment Creditors 20-day deadline to respond to Garnishee's Answer is today, May 28, 2024. *See* § 77.061, Fla. Stat. In light of the foregoing, Judgment Creditors hereby request an additional fourteen (14) days to file their reply, or until June 11, 2024.
- 5. Enlargements of time are permitted with good cause by Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 6(b). Such enlargements of time should be liberally granted absent a showing of bad faith or undue prejudice. *See, e.g., Lizarazo v. Miami-Dade Corrections & Rehab. Dept.*, 878 F.3d 1008, 1012 (11th Cir. 2017) (citing *U.S. v. Miller Bros. Constr. Co.*, 505 F.2d 1031, 1035 (10th Cir. 1974)).
- 6. The extension of time is necessary for Garnishee to file its amended answer and prevent unnecessary filings—such as the Judgment Creditors reply to an Answer that Garnishee will soon be amending.

7. Based on the foregoing, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 6(b)(1)(A), Judgment Creditors have demonstrated good cause to extend the time to respond to Garnishee's Answer. Moreover, no party will be prejudiced by the relief requested in this Motion, and the Motion is not filed for the purposes of delay.

8. On May 28, 2024, Judgment Creditors conferred with Garnishee's counsel regarding the relief sought in this Motion, and Garnishee's counsel agreed to the fourteen (14) day extension, up to and including June 11, 2024.

9. A proposed Order granting the instant unopposed Motion is attached hereto.

WHEREFORE, Judgment Creditors respectfully request the Court to enter an Order granting the extension of time for Judgment Creditors to respond to Garnishee's Answer, up to and including June 11, 2024.
